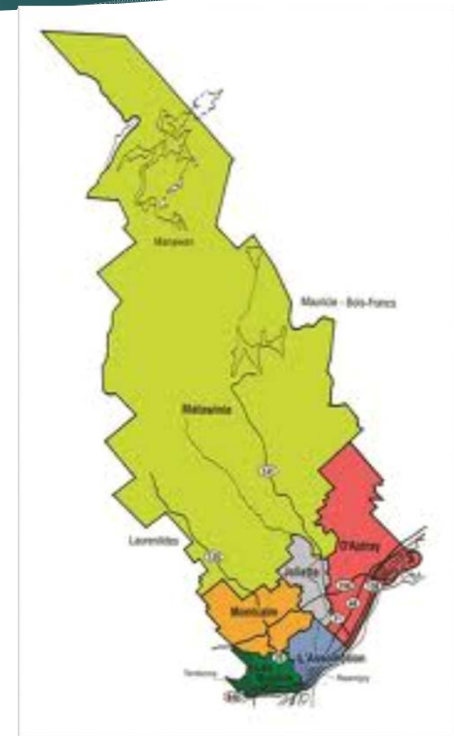

- ▶ Population-based responsibility
- ▶ Aging population with growing health needs
- ▶ Incidence on chronic disease
- ▶ Facing major challenges
  - ▶ Accessibility

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- ▶ Implementation of Nurse proximity consultation team

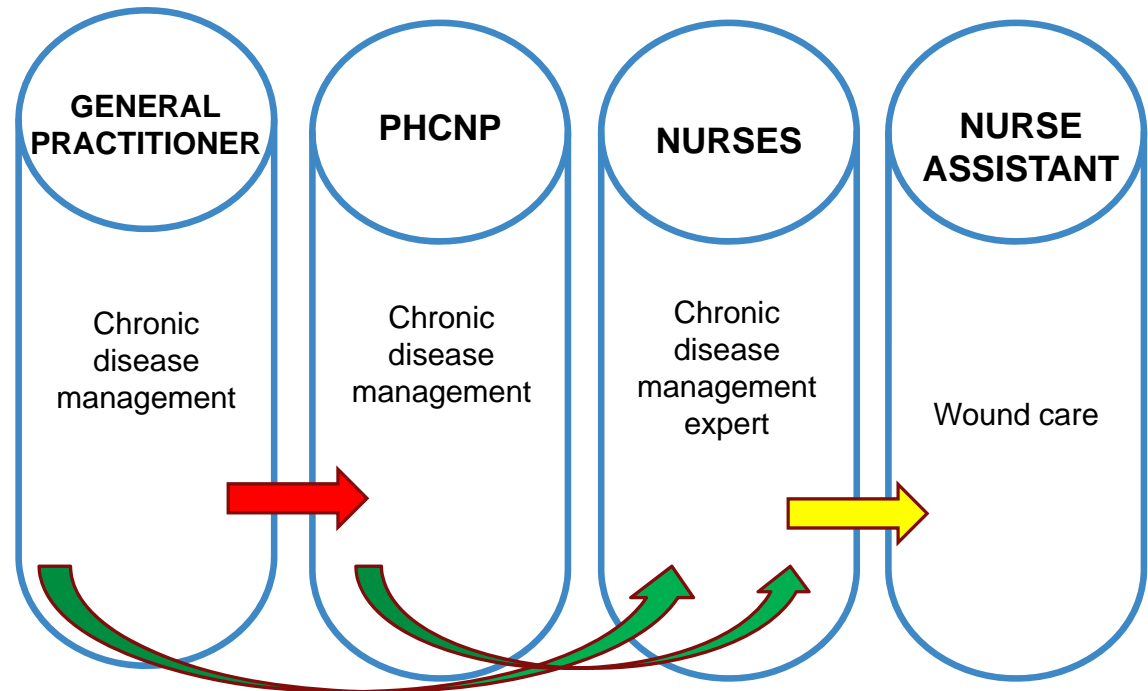
# Nurse proximity consultation team

- ▶ Team at St-Gabriel-de-Brandon
- ▶ Target patients with chronic disease
- ▶ Based on a full scope of nursing practice
- ▶ Application of National collective prescriptions of Quebec
  - ▶ Diabetes
  - ▶ Hypertension
  - ▶ Dyslipidemia
- ▶ Standardize case management
- ▶ Advanced access for registered patient's



# Nurse proximity consultation team

- ▶ Revision of the services
- ▶ Team work restructuration
- ▶ Increase overall access
- ▶ Advanced access



# What can nurses do to solve the primary care woes of the Canadian health care systems?

- ▶ Leaders in chronic disease case management
- ▶ Population health needs
- ▶ Full scope of the nursing practice
  - ▶ Assessment and care planning
  - ▶ Teaching of patients and families
  - ▶ Communication and care coordination
  - ▶ Integration and supervision of staff
  - ▶ Quality of care and patient safety
  - ▶ Knowledge updating and utilization
- ▶ Team work to enhance interdisciplinary



# Nurse proximity consultation team

- ▶ Implementation : September 2014
- ▶ 70 registered patients
- ▶ CLSC St-Gabriel-de-Brandon
- ▶ 2 nurses 2 days/week
- ▶ 80 Follow-up of patients per month
  
- ▶ Partnership with a private medical clinic
- ▶ 40 registered patients
- ▶ 60 Follow-up of patients per month
